WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI HARI SREEDHAR presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue such appropriate writ, order or direction more so particularly one in the nature of Mandamus declaring the inaction of the third respondent in deciding the preliminary objection of the petitioner with regard to maintainability of the proceeding relating to Notice No. E1/830-16/2025 initiated by the third respondent on the Application No. RC2300005764, dated 2-6-2023 of the fifth respondent in respect of the land of Ac. 3-07 gts in Sy. No.351/AA11 of Bommaraspet village, Shamirpet mandal, Medchal-Malkajgiri District and proceeding further with the matter without even furnishing the documents directed to be furnished to me by this Court in its order dated 23-9-2025 in WP No.29025 of 2025 and not giving notice of the case in advance, is clearly arbitrary, illegal, unfair and in violation of principles of natural justice;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. HARI SREEDHAR, Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.5 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
