ORDER

When this matter is taken up for consideration, Sri M.P.Kashyap, learned counsel, submits that he has instructions to appear on behalf of respondent No.2 and seeks a short adjournment for filing vakalat and to proceed with the matter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner express urgency on the ground that the Investigating Officer is taking coercive steps against the petitioner.

In view of the above submissions, list this matter on 15.06.2026 along with Crl.P.No.6489 of 2026 in 'adjourned motion list'.

Till then, the Investigating Officer is directed not to take coercive steps against the petitioner. However, the petitioner shall cooperate with the Investigating Officer.
