are directed to show cause on or before 15.06.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit/grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings in Crime in FIR No. 104/2025 Registered by Economic Offences Wing (EOW) Police Station, Cyberabad Commissionerate, in so far as they relate to the Petitioners/Accused No. 4 and 5 are concerned including arrest and consequently direct that no coercive action be taken against the Petitioners pursuant to the said FIR and pass such other orders as are deemed fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case, in the interests of justice., Pending disposal of CRLP No 7345 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following:

ORDER

When this matter is taken up for consideration, Sri M.P. Kashyap, learned counsel, submits that he has instructions to appear on behalf of respondent No. 2 and seeks a short adjournment for filing vakalat and to proceed with the matter.

Learned counsel for the petitioners expresses urgency on the ground that the Investigating Officer is taking coercive steps against the petitioners.

In view of the above submissions, list the matter on 15.06.2026 in the 'adjourned motion list' along with CrI.P.No.6489 of 2026.

Till then, the Investigating Officer is directed not to take coercive steps against the petitioners/accused Nos.4 and 5. However, the petitioners shall cooperate with the Investigating Officer.
