WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate SRI KAVALI VISHNU KANTH presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondent No.4 in filing E.P. No.96 of 2025 in AA/ CF No.539 of 2024 before the Court of the I-Additional Junior Civil Judge-cum-I Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Hanamkonda and the consequential

attachment of salaries of the petitioners pursuant thereto as illegal, arbitrary, without jurisdiction and contrary to the provisions of the Chit Funds Act, 1982 and consequently set aside all further proceedings in E.P. No.96 of 2025.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI KAVALI VISHNU KANTH Advocate for the Petitioners and GP FOR STAMPS AND REGISTRATION for the Respondents no. 1 to 3 directed issue of notice to the Respondent no.4 to 6 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 29.07.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend all further proceedings including the salary attachment orders issued in E.P. No.96 of 2025 in AA/CF No.539 of 2024 on the file of the Court of the I-Additional Junior Civil Judge-cum-I Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Hanamkonda, pending disposal of WP No 15637 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

**The Court made the following**

**ORDER:**

**Notice before admission.**

**Learned Government Pleader of Stamps and Registration takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3, waives further notice, and seeks time to file a counter affidavit.**

**Registry is directed not to take out further notices to respondent Nos.1 to 3, in view of the above waiver.**

**Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.4 through Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and to file proof of service in the Registry by the next date of hearing.**

**Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that a Division Bench of this Court, in *Punyamuthula Venkata Viswa Sundara Rao and another v. M/s. Margadarsi Chit Fund Private Limited and others* [(2017) 3 ALD 387 (DB)], has categorically held that an E.P. Court lacks the jurisdiction to entertain an application for execution of the award**

passed by the Deputy Registrar of Chit Funds, if presented by the decree-holder. However, in the present case, respondent No.4 has straight away filed an execution petition on the file of the I-Additional Junior Civil Judge-cum-I Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Hanamkonda. Therefore, learned counsel seeks indulgence of this Court.

Having regard to the above made submissions and in view of the decision of the Division Bench of this Court in *Punyamuthula Venkata Viswa Sundara Rao* (supra), there shall be interim stay as prayed for, in respect of the petitioners herein.

Post this matter on 29.07.2026, for counter affidavit.
