Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased In the circumstances, it is prayed that this Hon'ble High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction or more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring action of the respondent no 4 in issuing the termination Notice vide RC No 1617/B2/2024 dated 11/06/2025 without following the due process of law consequent to issuing show cause notice vide proceedings no RC No. 1617/B2/24 dated 04/06/2025 in pursuance of the proceedings issued by Respondent No.3 vide Proceedings No. 32/RC1/DSC/2024/TRT/2025 dated 30/05/2025 by declaring all of them illegal arbitrary, contrary to law and violative of the principles of natural and violative of Article 14 and 19, 21 and 300 A of Constitution of India, and consequently set aside both proceedings dated 30/05/2025 by Respondent No.3 show cause dated 04/06/2025 and Termination
