Government Pleader for Stamps and Registration for the respondent.

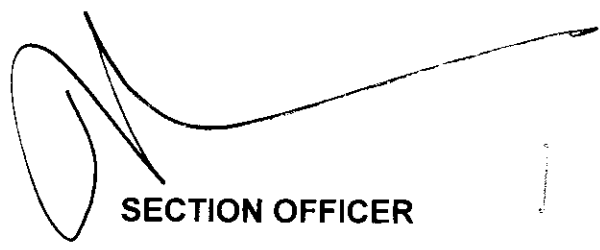

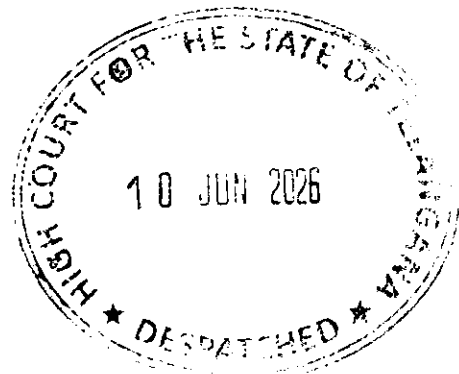
