WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI G. MADHUSUDHAN REDDY presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the respondents in attaching the salary of the petitioner vide order dated 10.4.2026 in EP No. 96 OF 2024 in Arb No. 977 of 2024 on the file of Principal Junior civil Judge at Karimnagar as arbitrary and contrary to the provisions of law and contrary to the law laid down by Division Bench of this Hon'ble court I Punyamurthala Venkat viswa sundara rao vs margadarsi chit fund private ltd reported in 2017 (3) ALD 387 consequently to set aside the attachment of salary order dated 10.4.2026 in EP No. 96 OF 2024 in Arb No. 977 of 2024 on the file of Principal Junior civil Judge at Karimnagar.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI G. MADHUSUDHAN REDDY Advocate for the Petitioner and GP FOR STAMPS AND REGISTRATION for the Respondents no. 1 to 3 directed issue of notice to the Respondents no. 4 to 6 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 29.07.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings in attaching the salary of the petitioner vide order dated 10.4.2026 in EP No. 96 OF 2026 in Arb No. 977 of 2024 on the file of Principal Junior civil Judge at Ranga reddy LB Nagar. pending disposal of WP No 15939 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following

ORDER:

Notice before admission.

Learned Government Pleader of Stamps and Registration takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3, waives further notice, and seeks time to file a counter affidavit.

Registry is directed not to take out further notices to respondent Nos.1 to 3, in view of the above waiver.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.4 through Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and to file proof of service in the Registry by the next date of hearing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a Division Bench of this Court, in *Punyamuthula Venkata Viswa Sundara Rao and another v. M/s. Margadarsi Chit Fund Private Limited and others* [(2017) 3 ALD 387 (DB)], has categorically held that an E.P. Court lacks the jurisdiction to entertain an application for execution of the award passed by the Deputy Registrar of Chit Funds, if presented by the decree-holder. However, in the present case, respondent No.4 has straight away filed an execution

petition on the file of the Principal Junior Civil Judge cum Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Karimnagar. Therefore, learned counsel seeks indulgence of this Court.

Having regard to the above made submissions and in view of the decision of the Division Bench of this Court in *Punyamuthula Venkata Viswa Sundara Rao* (supra), there shall be interim stay as prayed for, in respect of the petitioner herein.

Post this matter on 29.07.2026, for counter affidavit.
