Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to pass an order or orders one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS the G.O.Rt.No.598 Agriculture and Cooperation (Coop-II) Dept., dt.19.12.2025 for appointment of official person in charge committees for 9 Districts Co-operative Central Banks by appoint the respective head quarter, Collector and District Magistrate as Official Person-In-charge Committee/Respondent No.3 in Sl.No.2 for each District Co-operative Central Bank by violating the G.O.Rt.No.386, A and C (Coop- II) Department dated 14.08.2025 duly superseding the orders and exemption from the time limit specified in Sec.32 (7)(a) of TCS Act, 1964 by invoking U/s.123 of TCS Act, 1964 in order to complete reorganization of PACS/DCCBs for formation of new District and new Mandals as soon as possible as illegal, arbitrary and violation of the Sec.34, and Rule 10 and 30 of Co-operative Societies Act, 1964 and consequently suspend the G.O.Rt.No.598 Agriculture and Cooperation (Coop-II) Dept., dt.19.12.2025 by violating the provisions under section 34 and Rule 10 and 30 of the Act, 1964 without giving any notice or permit to submit representation inspite of as per G.O.Rt.No.386, dated 14.08.2025, the Petitioners are appointed shall discharge all the functions of the committee and perform all such activities in the interest of society as specified the provisions of the Rules and Act, 1964 and Byelaws made under and permit to continue the petitioners till conduct of the elections;

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the G.O.Rt.No.598 Agriculture and Cooperation (Coop-II) Dept., dt.19.12.2025 issued by the Respondent No.1 and continue the Petitioners as per proceedings in Rc. No.1297/2025/DCCB, dated 22.02.2025, forthwith, pending disposal of WP No 15878 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.
