WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through their Advocate Sri. R ANURAG presented this Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be to quash the proceedings against the petitioners/accused No.2 and 3 in F.I.R.No.19 of 2026 on the file of Women Police Station, Nalgonda,

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. R ANURAG Advocate for the Petitioner, Public Prosecutor, for the Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 06.07.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of

grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

I.A. NO: 2 OF 2026

Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings including the arrest if the Petitioners/ Accused No.2 and 3 in F.I.R.No.19 of 2026 on the file of Women Police Station, Nalgonda, Pending disposal of CRLP No 7512 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following:

ORDER

Notice before admission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have not committed any offences and have been falsely implicated in the present crime by making omnibus allegations solely on the ground that they are the parents of accused No.1. Even according to the allegations made in the complaint, the ingredients of Sections 85 and 115(2) read with Section 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 are not attracted against the petitioners. He further submits that, at the instance of elders and well-wishers, the petitioners, accused No.1, and respondent No.2 entered into a Memorandum of understanding on 08.03.2025. Thereafter, respondent No.2 filed the present complaint by giving a criminal colour only with an intention to harass the petitioner's. Hence, the continuation of proceedings against the petitioners is a clear abuse of process of law.

Taking into consideration the above submissions, this Court is of the view that detailed examination is required for adjudication of the case.

Post on 06.07.2026.

Till such time, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings against the petitioners/accused Nos.2 and 3 in FIR No.19 of 2026 of Nalgonda Women Police Station, Nalgonda District.

In default of filing proof of service, the stay stands vacated.
