WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI PUDOTA SRI HARSHITH presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more preferably one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the records pertaining to the impugned Award dated 29.08.2023 passed in ABR/CF No.317 of 2022 and consequential Recovery Certificate dated 24.11.2023 issued by the 2nd Respondent, together with all consequential proceedings including E.P.No.1169 OF 2024 and after examining the legality thereof, be pleased to quash and set aside the same as illegal, arbitrary, without jurisdiction and contrary to law.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. PUDOTA SRI HARSHITH Advocate for the Petitioner and GP FOR STAMPS AND REGISTRATION, for the respondent Nos. 1 & 2, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.3, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 27.08.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings in E.P.No.1169 OF 2024 IN ABR/CF/No.317 OF 2022 pending before the V Junior Civil Judge, City Civil Court at Hyderabad including proceedings under Order XXI Rule 48 CPC for attachment and deduction of salary, pending disposal of WP No 19074 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

ORDER

Notice before admission.

Learned Government Pleader for Stamps and Registration takes notice for respondents 1 and 2, waives further notice and seeks time to file a counter affidavit.

In view of the above waiver, Registry is directed not to take out notices to respondents 1 and 2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to take out personal notice to respondent No.3 by Registered Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service into Registry by the next date of hearing.

Post on 27.08.2026 for counter affidavit.

Pending the writ petition, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings in E.P.No.1169 of 2024 in ABR/CF/No.317 of 2022 pending on the file of V Junior Civil Judge, City Civil Court, Hyderabad, insofar as petitioner is concerned, subject to petitioner depositing 50% of the amount ordered to be withheld, within a period of two weeks from today.

As and when the amount is deposited, respondent No.3 is at liberty to withdraw the said amount.
