Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to serve a set of material papers to the learned Standing Counsel appearing for respondent No.2.

Post on 06.07.2026 in the adjourned motion list.

The presence of the petitioners/accused Nos.1 and 2 in C.C.No.2621 of 2025 on the file of the IV Additional Junior Civil Judge-cum-XV Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Kukatpally, is dispensed with, subject to the condition that they shall be represented through their counsel on each and every date of hearing. If the presence of the petitioners is required, they shall appear before the trial Court. In case of their non-appearance on the specific date fixed by the trial Court for their appearance, the trial Court is entitled to proceed with the matter, in accordance with law.
