WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri MD FASIUDDIN presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly a Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action/inaction of the respondents, particularly Respondents Nos. 1 to 5, in not acting upon the petitioner's representation dated 12.03.2026 (Annexure-P1) and in permitting the 6th respondent to continue in unauthorized occupation of the R & B Guest House (Circuit House), Bhainsa, as illegal, arbitrary and violative of Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the respondents to take appropriate action by evicting the 6th respondent, restoring the property to its original condition, initiating recovery of damages to public property.
