Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, to declare the action of the respondent authorities in threatening to dispossess the petitioner from his respective land bearing its Sy.No. 56/AA, to an extent of Ac 7-0600 gts, Situated at Aushapur Village, Ghatkesar Mandal, Medchal Malkajgiri District, without issuing any notice and without following the procedure contemplated under the Law, as being illegal, arbitrary, unjust and violative of Article 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents authorities to not to take any coercive steps without following the due process of Law.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondent authorities not to dispossess or in any manner interfere with the peaceful

possession and enjoyment of the petitioner from his respective land bearing its Sy.No. 56/AA, to an extent of Ac 7-0600 gts, Situated at Aushapur Village, Ghatkesar Mandal, Medchal Malkajgiri District, pending disposal of WP No 16079 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.
