01.	08.06.2026	<p><u>JSR, J</u></p> <p>This Criminal Petition is filed by the petitioners/accused Nos.1 to 3 seeking to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.6834 of 2022 on the file of the learned XV Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Hyderabad.</p> <p>Heard Mr.Yogeshwar Raj Saxena, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr.Jithender Rao Veeramalla, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for respondent No.1.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that, at the instance of elders and well-wishers, the petitioners and respondent No.2 have entered into a settlement and executed a Memorandum of Understanding. The same was filed in FCOP No.942 of 2025 before the II Additional Family Court-cum-XV Additional Metropolitan Sessions Judge, Kalpatharu Complex, City Civil Court, Hyderabad, and the learned Magistrate allowed the said FCOP on 17.02.2026. He further submits that both the parties have filed applications vide I.A. Nos. 2 and 3 of 2026 seeking permission to compound the offence and to record the compromise.</p>	Transferred to i.o. folder before corrections, if any.

Learned counsel further submits that the parties will appear before the High Court Legal Services Committee for identification.
