I.A.No.1 of 2026 is ordered accordingly. <u>LAAS.No.39 of 2026</u> and <u>LAAS.No.8 of 2021</u> Learned counsel appearing for the respondents/claimants passes an order dated 28.06.2022 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench in I.A.No.2 of 2021 in L.A.A.S.No.8 of 2021, wherein, the Co-ordinate Bench granted interim stay of the impugned order subject to the petitioner's depositing the entire amount awarded by the Reference Court along with costs and interest without deducting income tax within a period of 8 weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of the order.
