Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to vacate the stay orders dated 13.11.2025 passed in IA No. 3 of 2025 in MACMA No. 1589 of 2025 by permitting the Petitioner/Respondent No. 1 and 2 to withdraw Rs. 15,15,067/- deposited by Appellant/Insurance Co., towards 50 % of the compensation amount before XI Additional Chief Judge, City Civil Court Hyderabad, pending disposal of MACMA No. 1589 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

IA No. 3 of 2025:

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to Stay of all further proceedings including the execution of Judgment and Decree, dt. 07-01-2025 in MVOP NO- 2134 of 2019 Passed by the MACT- XI Additional Chief Judge, City Civil Court at Hyderabad, pending disposal of MACMA No. 1589 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and the order of the High Court dated 13.11.2025 made in IA No. 3 of 2025 and upon hearing the arguments of Sri V SAMEASIVA RAO Advocate for the Respondent No.1 in IA No. 1 of 2026 and Smt.B ROJA RAMANI Advocate for the Petitioners in IA No. 1 of 2026.

The Court made the following

ORDER

This is an application filed by the petitioners/claimants, seeking to vacate the stay granted by this Court in I.A. No. 3 of 2025, dated 13.11.2025.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners; and learned Standing Counsel for the insurance company.

Learned Standing Counsel for the insurance company submits that the insurance company has deposited Rs.15,15,067, towards 50% of the awarded amount.

Considering the submissions made, the petitioners/claimants are permitted to withdraw 75% of the deposited amount (i.e., 75% of Rs.15,15,067) which comes to Rs.11,36,300.25 paise (rounded off to Rs.11,36,300).

The order in I.A. No. 3 of 2025 stands modified accordingly.
