No. 703 of 2022 on the file of XVI Additional District Judge, Ranga Reddy District at Malkajgiri in respect of subject property open land admeasuring 496 sq. meters in the Middle part of Plot No. 3, Jeedimetla Village, T.S. No. 11, Quthubullapur Municipal Circle and Mandal, Ranga reddy District as contrary to law, arbitrary, unjust, illegal and violative of principles of natural justice,
