WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri L SRINIVAS PATEL presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ of Certiorari or other appropriate order or direction in the nature of a Writ calling for the records resulting in the order in File No. F1/51 of 2019 dated

09-06-2023 passed by the 3rd respondent confirming the issuance of Occupancy Rights Certificate by the 4th respondent in favour of the 5th respondent and also endorsement in F1/999/2023 dated 23-09-2023 issued by the 4th respondent dismissing the Review Petition as being arbitrary, discriminatory and violative of Articles 14 and 300A of Constitution of India and provision of Telangana Abolition of Inams Act 1955 and consequently set aside the same and the ORC bearing No. J/8119/1993 dated 01/07/1996 issued in favour of the 5th respondent and consequently direct the 4th respondent to issue a fresh ORC jointly in favour of the petitioner and the respondents 5 to 7 and direct the respondent No.8 to maintain status quo over the subject lands in any manner and not to make any further constructions in the subject land in the interest of justice

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri L SRINIVAS PATEL, Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
