Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ of Mandamus, or any other appropriate Writ, Order/s, Direction/s i. to declare the actions of the Respondent No. 4 in seizing the Hospital of the Petitioner herein on 08.05.2026 without issuing any notice or conducting an enquiry or granting an opportunity of hearing to the Petitioner herein and also in cancelling the Trade

License bearing No. TR-4266-435-0001 issued in favour of the Petitioner as intimated to the Petitioner under the Panchanama dated 08.05.2026 as illegal, arbitrary, contrary to the provisions of the Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation Act 1955, in violation of the principles of natural justice and in violation of the Fundamental Rights guaranteed under Article 21 and Article 19(1)(g) of the Constitution of India and consequently set-aside all of such proceedings including the Panchanama dated 08.05.2026 by the Respondent No. 4 and the purported cancellation of Trade License bearing No. TR-4266-435-0001 of the Petitioner herein ii. permitting the Petitioner to re-open the Petitioners Hospital at premises bearing No. 5-109/3/B, Ground Floor, Opposite JRC Convention, Gacchibowli, Serilingampally, Ranga Reddy District, Telangana.
