COMMON ORDER:

This Criminal Appeal is filed under Section 374 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.'), against the judgment dated 25.05.2017 passed in S.C.No.311 of 2015 by the learned VIII Additional Senior Civil Judge, L.B.Nagar, Ranga Reddy District, whereby the appellant-accused No.1 was convicted for the offence under Section 498-A of IPC and he was sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment for three years and also to pay a fine of Rs.5,000/-, in default to undergo simple imprisonment for six months.

2. It is submitted by learned counsel appearing for the appellant as well as the respondent No.2, that during pendency of the present Criminal Appeal, the parties have compromised the matter. Accordingly, I.A. Nos. 1 and 2 of 2026 have been filed to permit them to compound the offences and to record the compromise between them.

3. Vide order dated 21.04.2026, this Court directed the parties along with their respective counsel to appear before the Secretary,



2. High Court Legal Services Committee, High Court for the State of Telangana, Hyderabad, for identification and to submit a report.

4. Pursuant to the above said direction issued by this Court, the parties have appeared and the Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, has identified the parties and submitted a report, dated 27.04.2026 and the same is placed on record.

5. The appellant and the 2nd respondent have resolved their issues. In view of the same and considering the report, dated 27.04.2026, I.A.Nos. 1 and 2 of 2026 filed to compound the offences and compromise the matter are allowed. Consequently, this Criminal Appeal is allowed and the conviction and sentence of imprisonment imposed against the appellant-accused No.1 in the judgment dated 25.05.2017 passed in S.C.No.311 of 2015 by the learned VIII Additional Senior Civil Judge, L.B.Nagar, Ranga Reddy District, is hereby set aside, subject to the appellant-accused No.1 paying an amount of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand Only) to the Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, High Court for the State of Telangana, Hyderabad and Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand Only) to the **Director, Sainik Welfare Fund, Hyderabad**, within a period of three (03) weeks from today and file proof of the



3. *Vide* order dated 30.07.2025, this Court directed the parties along with their respective counsel to appear before the Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, High Court for the State of Telangana, Hyderabad, for identification and to submit a report.
4. Pursuant to the above said direction issued by this Court, the parties have appeared and the Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, has identified the parties and submitted a report, dated 17.09.2025 and the same is placed on record.
5. The petitioner and the 2nd respondent have resolved their issues. In view of the same and considering the report, dated 17.09.2025, I.A.Nos.1 and 2 of 2025 filed to compound the offences and compromise the matter are allowed. Consequently, this Criminal Revision Case is allowed and the conviction and sentence of imprisonment imposed against the petitioner-appellant-accused in the judgment dated 13.01.2016 passed in Criminal Appeal No.196 of 2014 by the learned III Additional District and Sessions Judge, Ranga Reddy District, confirming the judgment dated 03.03.2014 passed in C.C.No.227 of 2013 by the learned IX Special Magistrate, Cyberabad, is hereby set aside subject to the petitioner/accused paying an amount of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand Only) to the Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, High Court for the

same before the Registry. The bail bonds of the appellant-accused No.1 shall stand cancelled.

6. Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall stand closed.
