WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate SRI L RAM SINGH presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents in harassing the petitioners by calling the petitioners to the Police Station, Rajendranagar and threatening with the false cases against the petitioners as illegal, arbitrary, violative of Article 21 of the Constitution of India and violation of principles of natural justice and consequently direct the official respondents to not to involve in a civil disputes and harass the petitioners by calling the petitioners to Police Station, Rajendranagar and interfere with the life and personal liberty of the petitioners;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. L RAM SINGH, Advocate for the Petitioners and GP for Home for the Respondent Nos.2 to 5, directed issue of notice

to the Respondent No.6 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

You viz:

are directed to show cause on or before 15-06-2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the official respondents to not to harass the petitioners by calling to the police station and interfere with life and personal liberty of the petitioners, pending disposal of WP No 16670 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following:

ORDER

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home for respondent Nos.2 to 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondent No.5 is repeatedly calling the petitioners to police station and forcing them to sit with the complainant to settle civil disputes. He further submits that the petitioners are threatened with false criminal cases if they did not comply with the demand to settle the civil matters with the unofficial respondent No.6. He further submits that the dispute is purely civil and that no FIR, much less involving cognizable offence is registered against the petitioners. He further submits that the police does not have jurisdiction to mediate or settle the property disputes and that repeatedly calling senior citizens to the police station, without any lawful authority infringes upon the personal liberty of the petitioners, besides causing mental harassment to the petitioners. He prays for a direction to the police not to call the petitioners to the police station/interfere with the life and personal liberty of the petitioners.

On the other hand, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home, on instructions, would submit that pursuant to complaint lodged by respondent No.6, FIR No.569/2026 dated 12.05.2026 under Sections 318(4), 316(2), 336(2) 338, 340(2) of BNS has been registered against petitioner No.2, who is arrayed as Accused No.1 therein. He further submits that the duty of the police calls upon them to intervene and to prevent breach of peace and the Writ Petition as framed and filed is not maintainable. He further submits that call records would falsify the claim of the petitioners that they have been repeatedly called by the police officials.

Without getting into the merits of the rival contentions, the respondent No.5 is directed to follow due process of law and comply with the relevant provisions and procedure prescribed under BNSS.

Issue notice to the respondent No.6.
