WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate M/s. HARSHEET REDDY LAW FIRM presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ or order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of the respondent Nos.3 and 4 in interfering in the civil matter arose between the petitioner and the respondent Nos.5 to 8 threatening to dispossess the petitioner from his land in respect of land admeasuring Ac.1-01 Guntas in Sy.No.69/A2/2/1, and agriculture land Ac.0-29 guntas in Sy.No.69/A1/1/2 situated at Gangaram village, Maheshwaram Mandal, Ranga Reddy District in O.S.No.73 of 2026 on the file of the Senior Civil Judge, Ranga Reddy District at Maheshwaram as illegal, arbitrary and violative of Article 21 of the constitution of India and also violation of Settled Principles of law laid down by the Honourable Constitutional courts.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of M/s. HARSHEET REDDY LAW FIRM Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue notice to the Respondent Nos.5 to 8, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 15-06-2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents 2 to 4 not to interfere / dispossess, and harass the petitioner in the civil disputes between the petitioner and Respondent Nos.5 to 8 in respect of admeasuring Ac. 1-01 Guntas in Sy.No.69/A2/2/1 and agriculture land Ac. 0-29 guntas in Sy.No.69/A1/1/2 situated at Gangaram Village, Maheshwaram Mandal, Ranga Reddy District for dispossession of the petitioner above said land by the respondents 3 and 4, pending disposal of WP.No.16682 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

THE COURT MADE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

Petitioner claims to be the absolute owner and possessor of agricultural land admeasuring Ac.1.01 guntas in Sy.No.69/A2/2/1, situated at Gangaram Village, Maheshwaram Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, having purchased the same under registered sale deed vide document No.1956 of 2023, dated 19.09.2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that due to interference from the unofficial respondent Nos.5 to 8, petitioner has filed O.S.No.73 of 2026 before the learned Senior Civil Judge, Ranga Reddy District at Maheshwaram, for perpetual injunction. He further submits that vide order dated 04.05.2026 in I.A.No.268 of 2026 in O.S.No.73 of 2026, the trial Court passed interim injunction restraining the unofficial respondents from interfering with the petitioner's possession over the suit schedule property. He further alleges that the respondent Nos.3 and 4 are acting at the behest of the unofficial respondents and have been trying to dispossess the petitioner, illegally calling him to the police station and are interfering with the civil disputes.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that the action of the police officials be declared as illegal and seeks a direction to the respondent-police not to interfere with the civil disputes or with the possession of the petitioner over the subject property.

On the other hand, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home, on instructions, would submit that the allegations of threatening, dispossession and interference with the possession of the petitioner over the subject property is false and incorrect. He further submits that upon receipt of a call at Dial 100 complaining of alleged trespass into the property, the concerned officials had visited the place and the same is sought to be falsely portrayed as interference in civil matters and attempts to dispossess the petitioner, which is absolutely false and incorrect.

Without going into the details of the dispute, the respondent No.4 is directed not to interfere with the petitioner's peaceful possession over the subject property and/or holdout threats to dispossess the petitioner from the

property, which is subject matter in O.S.No.73 of 2026 pending on the file of learned Senior Civil Judge, Ranga Reddy District at Maheshwaram.

Issue notice to the respondent Nos.5 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on the respondent Nos.5 to 8 through Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service thereof into Registry.
