Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondent No.1 to 3 in removing the petitioner's Iron Room from the land in Sy.No.82/E1/A/2, Sy.No.E/3/3 to an extent of

Ac.3.06 gts situated at Mansanpalle Village, Maheshwaram Mandal, Ranga Reddy District is illegal, arbitrary and in violation of Articles 14, 16, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondent No.1 to 4 not to interfere into the petitioner's land in Sy.No.82/E1/A/2, Sy.No.E/3/3 to an extent of Ac.3.06 gts situated at Mansanpalle Village, Maheshwaram Mandal, Ranga Reddy District by restoring the Iron Room in Sy.No.82/E1/A/2, Sy.No.E/3/3 to an extent of Ac.3.06 gts situated at Mansanpalle Village, Maheshwaram Mandal, Ranga Reddy District forthwith.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the Writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondent No.1 to 4 not to interfere into the petitioner's land in Sy.No.82/E1/A/2, Sy.No.E/3/3 to an extent of Ac.3.06 gts situated at Mansanpalle Village, Maheshwaram Mandal, Ranga Reddy District by restoring the Iron Room in Sy.No.82/E1/A/2, Sy.No.E/3/3 to an extent of Ac.3.06 gts situated at Mansanpalle Village, Maheshwaram Mandal, Ranga Reddy District forthwith, pending disposal of above writ petition.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri MOHD YASEEN AYYUBI Advocate for the Petitioners, GP FOR HOME for the Respondent Nos.1 to 3 , Smt. P. BHAVANA RAO, Counsel for Respondent No.4 and the Court made the following:

ORDER

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home.

Smt. P. Bhavana Rao, learned counsel, waives notice for respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there is an order of restraint against the police officials not to interfere with the personal life and liberty of the petitioners except under due process of law, which was granted in W.P. No.14853 of 2026.

Learned counsel further submits that, despite the said order being in force, respondent No.3-SHO, Maheshwarani, and his staff are interfering in the civil disputes between the petitioners and respondent No.4 concerning the property involved in the civil dispute.


Reiterating the order granted by this Court in W.P. No.14853 of 2026, respondent No.3 and other police officials are directed not to interfere with the civil disputes between the petitioners and respondent No.4 except to prevent breach of peace based on a specific written complaint disclosing a cognizable offence or to execute a lawful order from the competent Court.

Learned counsel for respondent No.4 seeks time to file counter.
