WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI.S GANESH presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to pass an orders, or issue any directions or issue any appropriate writ more particularly in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of the Respondents No. 3 in trying to arrest the petitioners highhandedly in relation to Crime.No. 228 of 2026 dated 11.05.2026 registered on the file of the Station House Officer, Matwada Police Station. Warangal District without following the procedure contemplated under Section 35 (3) of BNSS (41A of CR.P.C), and in contrary to guidelines issued by the Apex court in Arnesh Kumar vs. State of Bihar as illegal, arbitrary and violation of Article 14 and 21 of Constitution of India, consequently direct the respondents No. 3 to follow the procedure contemplated under Section 35 (3) of BNSS (41A of CR.P.C) in relation to above crime registered against petitioner,

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. S GANESH Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.4, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
