Petition under Section 438 & 442 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL REVISION CASE, the High Court may be pleased to set aside the Judgment dated 21/04/2026 in CrI.Appeal No.1 of 2024 in C.C.No.344 of 2016, on the file of Principal Sessions Judge, Jangaon by allowing the Criminal Revision Case.

Petition under Section 430 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL REVISION CASE, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the sentence awarded in the Criminal Appeal No.1 of 2024 in C.C.No.344 of 2016 on the file of Principal Sessions Judge, Jangaon, pending disposal of CRLRC No.525 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri J.Kanakaiah Senior Counsel rep. for Sri Narendar Jali Advocate for the Petitioner, Public Prosecutor for the Respondent No.1, The court while directing issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this application should not be complied with, made the following

ORDER

Admit

Notice before admission.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 by SPAD and file proof of service in the Registry by the next date of hearing.

Heard Mr. J.Kanakaiah, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioner's counsel on record, would submit that: as against the judgment passed in C.C.No.344 of 2016 on the file of learned Principal Junior Civil Judge – cum – Judicial Magistrate of First Class, dated 17.01.2024, the petitioner has been found guilty for the offence punishable under Section 138 of N.I. Act and accordingly convicted under Section 255(2) of Cr.P.C. and was sentenced to suffer simple imprisonment for a period of six (06) months and to pay compensation of Rs.6.00 lakhs to the complainant within a period of six (06) months from the date of that judgment.

Aggrieved by the judgment dated 17.01.2024, the petitioner preferred Crl.A.No.1 of 2024 on the file of Principal Sessions Judge, Jangaon. Subsequently, the said Criminal Appeal was dismissed by the learned Principal Sessions Judge, Jangaon *vide* its order dated 21.04.2026. However, the learned Principal District & Sessions Judge, Jangaon granted bail to the petitioner in Crl.M.P.No.99 of 2026 in Crl.A.No.1 of 2024 subject to the petitioner executing a personal bond for Rs.25,000/- with two sureties for like sum each to the satisfaction of the said Court and to deposit 20% of the compensation amount.

Learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is out of jail and has fair chances to succeed in the present revision case.

This matter requires detailed examination upon hearing of the respondent.

In view of the facts and circumstances, this Court deems it appropriate to suspend the judgment passed in Crl.A.No.1 of 2024 by the learned Principal Sessions Judge, Jangaon, confirming the order passed by the learned Principal Junior Civil Judge – cum – Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Jangaon subject to the condition of petitioner depositing an amount of Rs.1,50,000/- to the credit of C.C.No.344 of 2026 on the file of learned Principal Junior Civil Judge – cum – Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Jangaon within a period of 30 working days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

List this matter on 12.06.2026.
