WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI LARAIB ABU TOUF presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ of a Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ and direct the 1st respondent to act in accordance with law and not to interfere with or dispossess the petitioner from HNo44/2RT Municipal No19- 2-369/39 consisting of ground and first floor admeasuring 144165 square yards situated at Chandulal Baradari Hyderabad in order to help Respondents 2 and 3 and to resolve the disputed claim of Respondents 2 and 3 except in accordance with law and except by way of a civil law remedy and grant such other relief as this Honble Court deems fit in the circumstances of the case .

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. LARAIB ABU TOUF Advocate for the Petitioner, ASST GP FOR HOME, for the respondent Nos. 1 & 4, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos. 2 & 3, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

You viz:

1. The Inspector of Police, Kalapather Police Station Kalapather Hyderabad.
2. The Principal Secretary Home Department, State of Telangana, Secretariat Hyderabad.

are directed to show cause on or before 22.06.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the 1st respondent not to interfere with or dispossess the petitioner from the subject house bearing HNo44/2RT Municipal No19-2- 369/39 consisting of ground and first floor admeasuring 144165 square yards situated at Chandulal Baradari Hyderabad in his pursuit of extending out-of-way favour to Respondents 2 and 3, pending disposal of WP No 16719 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following:

ORDER

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the Police are interfering in civil disputes between the petitioner and respondent Nos.2 and 3.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home, appearing on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 4, on the other hand, submits that the Police have not interfered in any civil disputes between the petitioner and respondent Nos.2 and 3.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader further submits that on the complaint of respondent No.3, a crime has been registered, in which the petitioner herein is not arrayed as accused. He also submits that similarly, on the complaint of the petitioner, a crime has been registered in which respondent Nos.2 and 3 are shown as accused.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader further submits that any visit to the subject property is only in furtherance of the investigation and that there is no un-warranted interference in the civil disputes.

Issue notice to the respondent Nos.2 and 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to the respondent Nos.2 and 3 and file proof of service in the Registry.

List the matter on 22.06.2025.
