Petition Under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents in rejecting the candidature of the Petitioner for admission into LL.M. course under Resident Student of Telangana - SC Group II category solely on the ground that the Petitioner pursued LL.B. course outside the State of Telangana as illegal, arbitrary, unreasonable, violative of Articles 14, 15 and 21 of the

Constitution of India and contrary to the object underlying reservation for Resident Students of Telangana and direct the Respondents to consider the candidature of the Petitioner for admission into LL.M. course under Resident Student of Telangana - SC Group II category in a fair, reasonable and constitutional manner.

Petition Under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents to keep one seat vacant in LL.M. course under Telangana SC Group II category or alternatively permit the Petitioner to provisionally participate in the admission process and attend classes pending disposal of the writ petition.

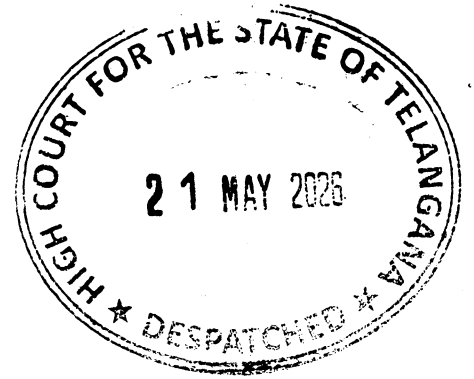
