Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue any appropriate writ, order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus by declaring the action of the respondents in not taken any action of representation of the petitioner, dated 22-07-2019 and 09-08-2019 regarding the illegal and unauthorised construction by the respondent nos. 8 and 9 without any valid permission, in the government land surrendered by H.No.46-50 and sides of Siva Temple, front and back side of H.Nos.46-51-52, with pillars and slab (G plus 2), Sanjay Gandhi Nagar, Upperguda, falling under GHMC, Near Moula Ali, Malkajgiri, (Medchal/Malkajgiri District) Ranga Reddy District, and consequentially direct the respondents 3 and 7 to demolish the illegal and unauthorised construction by the respondent Nos. 8 and 9;

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI B SIVA PRASAD Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR REVENUE for the Respondent Nos. 1, 3, 6 & 7, GP FOR MA & UD for respondent No.2 and SRI CHOTLA MADHU, Standing Counsel for respondent Nos. 4 and 5, the Court made the following.
