Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of

Mandamus, declaring the action of the respondents police particularly 3rd and 4th respondent police giving threatening calls to the petitioners by calling to his police station without having any valid reasons or without registering any crime, on the pressure and influence of the unofficial respondents 5 to 7 without having any jurisdiction by the 4th respondent harassing the petitioner by calling the petitioners to appear before the 4th respondent police without following the apex court guidelines harassing the petitioners is illegal, arbitrary and against the principles of natural justice and also violative of Articles 14, 19 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the 3rd and 4th respondent police not to harass the petitioners by calling to their police station by giving threatening calls to the petitioners without having any valid reasons or without registering any complaint and to pass in the interest of justice,

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to Direct the respondents police particularly 3rd and 4th respondent not to harass the petitioners by calling to the police station by giving threatening calls to the petitioner to appear before the 4th respondent without having any valid reasons, Pending disposal of WP No 16967 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI Abdul Rab Malik Advocate for the Petitioners, Gp For Home for the Respcndents 1 to 5, and the Court made the following.

ORDER

The respondent-Police authority shall not interfere with the civil rights of the petitioners and not to threaten the petitioners, without following due process of law.

Learned Government Pleader is directed to get instructions.
