Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased For the reasons stated in the accompanying affidavit, the Petitioner herein prays that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the inaction of the respondent authorities, more particularly Respondent No.4, in failing to renew the permission of Acharya Vidyalaya for classes from Nursery to 7th for the academic years 2026-2027 to 2030-2031, paid challan on dated 30.10.2025 pursuant to Application No. RNL20260250908 dated 18.02.2026, the respondent No. 5 got issued paper publication on dated 24.05.2026 stating that school does ~~not~~ not have government approval for the year 2026-2027, saying that not permitting to admissions without any authorization or permission, by remarks the application as

the latest LEASED DEED is not provided have it is not possible to renewed of this is for your kind information and necessary action by the respondent No. 5, violating the GO. No. 1 of 1984 the respondent No. 5 without any orders issued a proceedings No. 573/2025 dated 12.12.2025 inspite of third party objections for extension of lease and violation of the Education Act, as being wholly illegal, arbitrary, and unsustainable in law, passed without issuance of any notice, in clear violation of the principles of natural justice, and contrary to Articles 14 and 21A of the Constitution of India consequently. suspend the remarks on 18.02.2026 remarks the application as the latest LEASED DEED is not provided have it is not possible to renewed of this is for your kind information and necessary action by the respondent No. 5, and permit the petitioner to run the classes from Nursery to 6th class by suspending the paper publication 18.02.2026 permit to run the petitioner school.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondent authorities to provisionally permit the Petitioner School to continue to run classes from Nursery to 7th class for the academic year 2026-2027 the respondent no 5 issued notice on dated 24.05.2026 stating that the school does not have approval for the year of 2026-2027, and subsequent years pursuant to the Application No. RNL20260250908 dated 18.02.2026, without insisting upon submission of renewed lease deed, pending disposal of WP No 17046 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri K Buchi Babu Advocate for the Petitioner and GP for School Education for the Respondent Nos. 1 to 5, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

In the circumstances stated, the case of the petitioner is that the Lease Deed dated 26.02.2016 expired in January, 2026. However, the petitioner had filed a suit in O.S.No.1 of 2024 before the learned V-Additional District Judge, Bodhan, and pending adjudication of the said suit, an ad-interim injunction has been granted in I.A.No.65 of 2024, dated 20.02.2024, which has been extended from time to time and is subsisting as on today.

In that view of the matter, since the petitioner is running the Educational Institution under the society by name "Akshara Lakshmi Educational Society", the respondent authorities are directed to consider the case of the petitioner for extension of recognition for the present year.

In light of the above, post the matter on 15.06.2026 in the 'Motion List'.
