Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, preferably in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of Respondent Nos.6 and 7 in interfering with the civil dispute relating to Plot No.20 Part and Plot No.21 Part in Sy.No.226/A, situated at Gagilapur Village, Dundigal, Medchal-Malkajgiri District, and harassing the petitioner at the instance of Respondent No.8 as illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional and violative of Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the Respondent Nos.6 and 7 not to interfere in the civil dispute or dispossess the petitioner except by due process of law.

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026:

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondent No.3 and 4 in pursuance pleased to direct the Respondent Nos.6 and 7, their subordinates, agents or any person acting under their authority, not to interfere with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the petitioner over Plot No.20 Part and Plot No.21 Part in Sy.No.226/A, situated at Gagilapur Village, Dundigal, Medchal-Malkajgiri District, and further not to summon, threaten, coerce or harass the petitioner in connection with the subject civil dispute at the instance of Respondent No.8, except in accordance with due process of law, pending disposal of WP No 17031 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the AFFIDAVIT filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. Ventrappagada Aravind Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR HOME for the Respondents, the Court made the following;

ORDER:

Heard both sides.

In the circumstances stated, the respondent-police are directed not to call the petitioner to the police station without there being any reason of cognizable offence and without following due process of law.
