Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ or order or direction more particularly a Writ of Mandamus declaring the inaction of the Respondents No.1 and 2 in granting permission / No-Objection as well as the Respondent No.3 in granting Affiliation to the 2nd Petitioner Institution for

the new course of Polytechnic Diploma in Computer Science and Engineering (CSE) (120 Seats) as approved by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) vide Extension of Approval, dated 16-03-2026, from the academic year 2026-27 being illegal, arbitrary and in violation of Article 14 and 30(1) of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the 1st and 2nd Respondents to issue the permission / No-Objection and the 3rd Respondent to grant affiliation for the new Polytechnic Diploma in CSE (120 seats) as approved by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) for the 2nd Petitioner institution from the academic year 2026-27.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the 1st and 2nd Respondents to process for grant of Permission / NOC as well as the 3rd Respondent for grant of Permission/No-Objection Certificate and affiliation to the 2nd Petitioner Institution for the new diploma course i.e., Computer Science and Engineering (CSE) (120 Seats) from the academic year 2026-27 as approved by AICTE vide Extension of Approval, dated 16-03-2026, pending disposal of the writ petition.

: ORDER :

This Writ Petition is filed seeking the following relief:

"...to issue a Writ or order or direction more particularly a Writ of Mandamus declaring the inaction of the respondents No.1 and 2 in granting permission/ No Objection as well as the respondent No.3 in granting Affiliation to the 2nd petitioner Institution for the new course of Polytechnic Diploma in Computer Science and Engineering (CSE) (120 Seats) as approved by All India Council for Technical Education AICTE vide Extension of Approval dated 16-03-2026, from the academic year 2026-27 being illegal, arbitrary and in violation of Article 14 and 30(1) of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the 1st and 2nd respondents to issue the permission/No Objection and the 3rd respondent to grant affiliation for the new Polytechnic Diploma in CSE (120 seats) as approved by All India Council for Technical

Education AICTE for the 2nd petitioner institution from the academic year 2026-27 and pass such other order or orders as this Court deems fit and proper..."

2. Heard Mr.Papaiah Peddakula, learned counsel representing Mr.Sai Charan Telaprolu, learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned Assistant Government Pleader for Education appearing for respondent Nos.1, 2 and 4, Ms. G.Poorna Sri, learned Standing Counsel for Telangana State Board of Technical Education and Training appearing for respondent No.3.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the 2nd petitioner institution obtained AICTE approval vide Extension of Approval dated 16.03.2026 for commencement of a Polytechnic Diploma Course in Computer Science and Engineering (CSE) with an intake of 120 seats for the academic year 2026-27. It is further submitted that despite submitting several representations and possessing the requisite infrastructure and other facilities, respondent Nos.1 and 2 have not granted permission/NOC and respondent No.3 has not granted affiliation for the said course and unless the approved intake is included in the ongoing TGPOLYCET-2026 counselling process, the petitioners would suffer irreparable loss. Hence, he seeks appropriate directions to respondent

Nos.1 to 3 to grant permission/NOC and affiliation for the said course and to respondent No.4 to include the approved intake in the ongoing counselling process.

4. The learned Assistant Government Pleader for Education and the learned Standing Counsel for SBTET submit that, as per the existing Government instructions, prior approval of the State Government is mandatory for the establishment of new professional colleges, introduction of new Diploma courses, and for any increase, decrease, closure or merger of existing courses. It is contended that no NOC issued without such prior approval would be valid. They further submit that, in respect of the petitioner's proposal for introduction of a Diploma in Computer Science and Engineering course with an intake of 120 seats, the same was forwarded to the Commissioner of Technical Education for obtaining the requisite Government approval and the matter is presently under consideration, with Government orders still awaited.

5. This Court, having considered the rival submissions of the learned counsel for the respective parties, is of the considered view that the writ petition can be disposed of by directing the 1st and 2nd respondents to consider the representation dated 28.03.2026

submitted by the petitioners and to issue the necessary permission/No Objection Certificate, and further directing the 3rd respondent to grant affiliation for the new Diploma course in Computer Science and Engineering with an intake of 120 seats in the 2nd petitioner institution for the academic year 2026–27, as approved by AICTE. The 4th respondent is also directed to include 70% of the approved intake of the said course in the ongoing TGPOLYCET-2026 admissions counselling for making admissions for the academic year 2026–27, in accordance with the AICTE approval dated 16.03.2026. The entire exercise shall be completed within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, so as to enable participation in the ongoing web counselling process. No costs.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed.

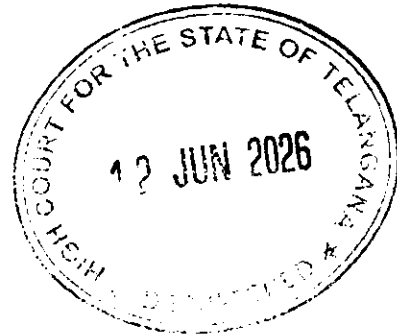
