The impugned order dated 01.06.2017 has reverted him to the post of Police Constable and allotted him to Andhra Pradesh on final allocation purportedly acting on his application. Petitioner as on date is serving in the State of Andhra Pradesh. He has made representations against his reversion on 31.05.2017 and 07.04.2026 before approaching this Court. The writ petition has been filed of course after about nine years of his reversion and reallocation to the Andhra Pradesh, but the legal question which remains to be answered is whether a person promoted to higher post could be reverted to a lower post even on the basis of an application by the incumbent</p>	

without any charges or proceedings warranting his reversion on any proved grounds of misconduct.

In view of the aforesaid legal issue involved, we are inclined to ignore the delay in approaching this Court, while asking the respondents to substantiate their stands.

Let counter affidavits be filed by both the States within four weeks.

List the matter after four weeks.
