WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate SRI. P V RAMANA presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction more in the nature of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents in not regularizing petitioners services in Class-III/Class IV categories as per their qualifications from the date of completion of 10 years of service from the date of their initial appointment, in spite of judgment of the Honorable Supreme Court of India, reported in 2006 (4) SCC 1 (CB), in the case between State of Karnataka Vs. Umadevi and in not fixing the regular Pay as per P.R.Cs., implemented by the Universities from time to time, in respect of their regular staff and in not counting the entire service from the date of their initial appointment to the date of regularization, for the purpose of pension and retirai benefits as illegal, arbitrary and in violation of the judgments rendered by the Hon Supreme Court of India, reported in 2006 (4) SCC 1 (CB), (State of Karnataka Vs. Umadevi, (M.L.Kesari) 2013 (14) SCC 65 (Nihal Singh Vs. State of Punjab), AIR 2025 SC 296 (Jago Vs. Union of India), 2025 Law Suit SC 1122, (Dharam Singh Vs. State of U.P), (2020 (4) ALD 379 (TS)dated 27-04-2020, (2025 Live Law (SC) 827) between Shah Samir Bharatbhai Vs. State of Gujarat, dated 22-08-2025 and (2026 Live Law, (SC)

95 in between Bhola Nath Vs. State of Jharkhand, dated 30-01-2026 as illegal, arbitrary and violates article- 14, 16 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequentially declare that the petitioners are entitled for regularization of their services from the date of completion of 10 years of service from the dates of their initial appointments and entitled for counting their service prior to the date of - regularization for the purpose of Pay and Pension with all Revision of Pay Scales in the suitable posts (Class-III or Class-IV) with all consequential benefits in the interest of justice,

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. P V RAMANA Advocate for the Petitioners, Assistant Government Pleader for Services-II for respondent No.1 Assistant Government Pleader for Services-III for respondent No.2 , directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos. 3 to 5, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Notice before admission.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Services-II takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and waives further notice. He seeks time to file counter affidavit.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Services-III takes notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and waives further notice. He seeks time to file counter affidavit.

Personal notice to respondent Nos.3 to 5 is permitted.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the subject matter in this Writ Petition falls within the purview of the decisions rendered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in State of Karnataka Vs. Umadevi¹, Nihal Singh Vs. State of Punjab², Jago Vs. Union of India³. Relying on the same, he seeks to pass appropriate orders.
