WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri. Mogili Anaveni presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying

that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the actions the Respondent No.4 in not following the procedure established by law and Respondent No.5 in withholding the salary of Petitioner by getting issued warrant dated 07.05.2026 in E.P. No. 9 of 2025 before in The II Addl. Chief Judge, City Civil Court at Hyderabad in ABR/CF/No. 237 of 2024 under the provisions of the AP Chit Fund Act, 1982, as filed by the 4th Respondent is illegal, arbitrary and without jurisdiction and against the principles of natural justice and consequently declare that the 3rd Respondent shall have no jurisdiction to entertain and pass the award in ABR/CF/No. 237 of 2024 dated 25.02.2025 at the instance of the 4th Respondent and consequential execution proceedings in E.P.No. 9 of 2025 on the file of the II Addl. Chief Judge, City Civil Court at Hyderabad as filed by the 4th Respondent are also illegal and unlawful;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. Mogili Anaveni Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No. 4 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 06.08.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings in pursuant to the E.P. No.9 of 2025 on the file of the II Addl. Chief Judge, City Civil Court at Hyderabad in ABR/CF/No. 237 of 2024 dated 25.10.2025, as filed by the 4th Respondent, as against the Petitioner, pending disposal of WP No 17651 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following:

ORDER:

Notice before admission.

Learned Government Pleader for Revenue General (Stamps and Registration) takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3, waives further notice and seeks time to file counter

Registry is directed not to take out notice to respondent Nos.1 to 3, in view of the above waiver.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.4 through Speed Post with acknowledgment Due and file proof of service in the Registry.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits in *Punyamurthula Venkata Viswa Sundara Rao v. Margadarsi Chit Fund Private Limited, Hyderabad and others* [2017 (2) ALD 387], the Division Bench of this Court held that the E.P. Court does not have jurisdiction to entertain an application for execution of the award passed by the Deputy Registrar of Chit Funds, if presented by the decree holder. However, in the instant case also, it appears, straightaway E.P. No.09 of 2025 in ABR/CF No.237 of 2024 was filed before the II Additional Chief Judge, City Civil Court at Hyderabad against the petitioner and others, without it being presented/forwarded by the Registrar. In view of the decision referred to above, balance of convenience is in favour of the petitioners.

Hence, there shall be interim stay as prayed for insofar as petitioners are concerned.
