WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through his/her Advocate SRI. P V RAMANA presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction, more particularly, one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the Respondents in not regularizing the services of the petitioners, after completion of 5 years of service from the dates of their initial appointments on 01-06-1987, 05-10-1988, 2-6- 1985, 5-3-1985, 1-4-1985, 1-2-1985 3-5-1986, 16-5-1986, 23-9-1987, 1- 11-1987, and 25-10-1987 under G.O.Ms.No.212, Finance Department, dated 22-4-1994, in spite of letters addressed by the Registrar of the University in Letter No.1470/Ser.II/2020, dated 29-8-2023 for regularization of our services as illegal, arbitrary and violative of Articles 14, 16, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and also in violation of the judgment rendered by the Supreme Court of India reported in 2006 (4) SCC 1 (CB), in the case between State of Karnataka Vs. Umadevi and other judgments i.e., (M.L.Kesari) 2013 (14) SCC 65 (Nihal Singh Vs. State of Punjab), AIR 2025 SC 296 (Jago Vs. Union of India), 2025 Law Suit SC 1122, (Dharam Singh Vs. State of U.P), (2020 (4) ALD 379 (TS) dated 27-04-2020, (2025 Live Law (SC) 827) between Shah Samir Bharatbhai Vs. State of Gujarat, dated 22-08-2025 and (2026 Live Law, (SC) 95 in between Bhola Nath Vs. State of Jharkhand, dated 30-01-2026 and consequentially declare that the petitioners are entitled for regularization of their services from the date on which they have completed 5 years of service with all regular Pay Scales adapted by the University from time to time with arrears and treating the period from the date of initial appointment to the date of regularization for the purpose of pension and other retiral benefits with all consequential benefits in the interest of justice,

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. P V RAMANA Advocate for the Petitioners, Assistant Government Pleader for Services-II respondent Nos.1 and 5 & Assistant Government Pleader for Services-III for respondent No.2, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos. 3 & 4, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

2. Scientist and Head, Live Stock Research Station, Badaneedapally, Mahabubnagar,

are directed to show cause on or before 20.07.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

The Court made the following

ORDER:

Notice before admission.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Services-II takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 5 and waives further notice. He seeks time to file counter affidavit.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Services-III takes notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and waives further notice. He seeks time to file counter affidavit.

Personal notice to respondent Nos.3 and 4 is permitted.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the subject matter in this Writ Petition falls within the purview of the decisions rendered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in State of Karnataka Vs. Umadevi¹, Nihal Singh Vs. State of Punjab², Jago Vs. Union of India³. Relying on the same, he seeks to pass appropriate orders.
