Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL REVISION CASE, the High Court may be to stay the operation of the, Impugned Order, dated 29/04/2025 in MC No. 38 of 2025 filed under Sec 125 of CrPC, 1973, on the File of Family Court-cum-III Addl District and Sessions Judge, Nizambad District at Nizambad, pending disposal of CRLRC No 605 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following

ORDER

This interlocutory application is filed by the petitioner seeking to stay the operation of the impugned order dated 29.04.2026 in M.C.No.38 of 2025, filed

under Section 125 of Cr.P.C., 1973, on the file of the learned Family Court-cum-III Additional District and Sessions Judge, Nizamabad District at Nizamabad, pending disposal of the case.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that no notice was served on the petitioner and that he was set *ex-parte* by the trial Court and that an amount of Rs.12,000/- per month to petitioner No.1 and Rs.5,000/- per month each to petitioner Nos.2 to 4 was awarded, whereas the income of the petitioner is only Rs.30,000/- per month. Therefore, he requested this Court to stay the operation of the said order.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and upon perusal of the certificate filed along with this application, the operation of the order dated 29.04.2026 passed by the trial Court is stayed, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall pay Rs.15,000/- per month to petitioner Nos.1 to 4 until the disposal of this Criminal Revision Case.

Accordingly, this interlocutory application is ordered.
