Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased issue a Writ or order preferably in the nature of Writ of Mandamus and after calling for records pertaining to the impugned Proceedings/Order Rc No 8020/DME/GT-26/58/65 dated 6-6-26 passed by 1st Respondent Proceedings/Order Circular Rc No 8020/DME/GT-26/2/58/65 dated 6-6-26 passed by 1st Respondent transferring the petitioner to the 5th Respondent college though the petitioner has not completed four years of service at Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad,/Government ENT Hospital Hyderabad as being arbitrary, illegal and contrary to the orders of the Government issued in G.O.Ms.No.38. Finance (HRM-())Department dated 21-4-26 and contrary to the orders passed by this Hon'ble court in WP No.19585/2024 dated 23-7-24 and consequently set aside the said impugned order as illegal, arbitrary, contrary to law and unconstitutional and issue a consequential direction directing the respondents to continue this petitioner as Assistant Professor, at Osmania Medical College Hydeabad/Government ENT Hospital, Hyderabad

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the impugned Proceedings/order impugned Proceedings/Order Rc No 8020/DME/GT-26/58/65 dated 6-6-26 passed by 1st Respondent and consequently direct the 1st Respondent to continue the petitioner at Govt ENT Hospital Hyderabad, pending disposal of WP No 17801 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Dr K Lakshmi Narasimha Advocate for the Petitioner and GP for Medical Health for the respondents, the Court made the following.
