Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction, more particularly in the nature of a WRIT OF MANDAMUS, declare that as per G.O.Ms.No.38, Finance (HRM-I) Department dated 21/04/2026, the expression station occurring therein has to be read in conjunction with service in the same department, and that service rendered in another department cannot be taken into account for the purpose of computing the total period of stay, and consequently declare that the petitioner is not liable to be transferred as she has not completed the mandatory period of four (4) years of service in the Directorate of Medical Education, and further declare that the action of the respondents in issuing the proceedings vide Rc.no. 8020/DME/GT-26/2/58/121, dated 06/06/2026 which were received by the petitioner on 09/06/2026 is arbitrary, illegal and contrary to law, and pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case .
