WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate M/s. K. R. K. V. PRASAD presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Certiorari by calling for the order dated 24.02.2020 in O.A.No.021/ 00854 2014 on the file of the Central Administrative Tribunal, Hyderabad and also the records pertaining to impugned letters Nos.32011/10/2011/-AD4, dated 15/22.04.2013, 24.07.2013 and 07.01.2014 and DoP&T OM No.35034/1/97-Estt., (D), dated 04.10.2012, and set aside the said letters along with the order dated 24.02.2020 duly declaring that the DoP&T instruction dated 04.10.2012 which has been made applicable to the juniors shall be applied to the petitioner also, duly declaring the action of the respondents in not granting Grade Pay and fixing the pay of the petitioner on par with juniors to the petitioner as illegal; and accordingly direct the respondents to grant 2nd financial up-gradation to PB-3 with GP Rs.5400/- w.e.f. 07.02.2007 to the petitioner with the consequential fixation of pay on par with his junior viz., L.Chandra Kumar and accordingly grant 3rd financial up-gradation to PB-3 with GP Rs.6600 from 28.01.2011 and step-up the pay of the petitioner on par with the said junior and accordingly grant all consequential benefits.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of M/s. K. R. K. V. PRASAD, Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this writ petition should not be admitted in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed in Writ Petition;
