WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate SRI M DAMODAR REDDY presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Certiorari, calling for the records in connection with the Order passed by the 2nd respondent in Case No. D1/80/2019 dated 23/06/2021 by directing the 4th respondent Tahsildar to delete the names of the respondents / petitioners in connection with the lands in Sy No. 20/A/A, 22/A/A, 80/A/A, 81/2A, 83/A, 147, 153/A, 154/A, 187/A of Pathamolgara village of Bhoothpur Mandal, Mahabubnagar District and restore the entries in the revenue records without considering the written arguments filed by the writ petitioners before the 2nd respondent by allowing case is highly illegal, arbitrary and against the principles of natural justice and also violative of Articles 14, 19, 21 and

300-A of Constitution of India by setting aside the order of the 2nd respondent dated 23/06/2021 and consequently direct the 4th respondent Tahsildar not to make any entries in the revenue records in connection with the subject property in the interest of justice. ✓

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI. M DAMODAR REDDY Advocate for the Petitioner and Government Pleader for Revenue for respondent Nos.1 to 4, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.5 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
