Mr. Avinash Desai, learned Senior Counsel appears for Mr. M.Pranav, learned counsel for the respondents. Petitioner has preferred this Contempt Case against the interim order dated 21.04.2025, passed in I.A.No.2 of 2025 in W.A.No.364 of 2025, whereby the respondents were directed to pay the compensation in respect of the directions mentioned at para 26(a) of the impugned order within thirty days and file an affidavit. Thereafter, the respondents informed the Court, on 02.07.2025, that they have filed compliance report. Petitioner, in this Contempt Case, has alleged that the computation of the amount has wrongly been done. He would be entitled to a much larger amount than Rs.6,26,625/- paid by them. On the other hand, respondents represented through Mr. Avinash Desai, learned Senior Counsel, have brought to the notice of the Court that in review I.A.No.1 of 2025, the learned writ court has modified the directions contained in paragraph 26 to the effect that the petitioner is entitled to pay revision for the years 2014, 2017 and 2023 as admitted by the respondents and also to the difference amount of Rs.6,26,625/-, which	Note: Transferred to (i/o) folder before corrections, if any. 		has been paid. Petitioner contends that the review petition was argued without any notice to him. Writ Appeal No.364 of 2025 is still pending.
