Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the Respondents, particularly Respondent Nos. 3 to 11, in unlawfully interfering with the Petitioners' peaceful possession, enjoyment, administration and management of Shaheed Baba Albail Singh Asthan admeasuring 7,637 Sq. Yards, equivalent to 'Ac.1-23 Gts.', situated in Sy. Nos.352/1 to 352/3 and 354/1 to 354/4 of Attapur Village, Rajendranagar Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, by obstructing and preventing the Petitioners from carrying on the religious and allied activities, restricting the entry and access of devotees and members of the Sikh Community, and attempting to alter the existing nature and physical features of the subject property, in violation of the order dated 29-01-2026 passed by this Court in W.P. No.44150 of 2017 and contrary to the official records, proceedings and communications of the Respondents themselves recognising the existence of Shaheed Baba Albail Singh Asthan and recording the continuous possession, occupation and enjoyment of the subject property by the Petitioners and the Sikh Community for more than one and a half centuries, as illegal, arbitrary, high-handed, without jurisdiction and violative of Articles 14, 21, 25, 26 and 300-A of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the Respondents particularly Respondents Nos. 3 to 11 not to interfere in any manner whatsoever with the Petitioners' peaceful possession, enjoyment, administration and management of Shaheed Baba Albail Singh Asthan situated in land admeasuring 7,637 Sq. Yards, equivalent to Ac.1-23 Gts., situated in Sy. Nos.352/1 to 352/3 and 354/1 to 354/4 of Attapur Village, Rajendranagar Mandal, Ranga Reddy District and not to obstruct or restrict the devotees and members of the Sikh Community from freely entering, accessing and offering prayers, not to alter the physical features of the subject property.

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026:

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct Respondents, particularly Respondents Nos. 3 to 11 not to interfere in any manner whatsoever with the Petitioners' peaceful possession, enjoyment, administration and management of Shaheed Baba Albail Singh Asthan situated in land admeasuring 7,637 Sq. Yards, equivalent to Ac.1-23 Gts., situated in Sy. Nos.352/1 to 352/3 and 354/1 to 354/4 of Attapur Village, Rajendranagar Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, pending disposal of WP No 18649 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Mr. B. Mayur Reddy, senior counsel for Sri. Sardar Jasbeer Singh Advocate for the Petitioners and , GP FOR MCPL ADMN AND URBAN DEV for the Respondents and Mr. Sameer Ahmad, standing counsel for respondents No.10 and 11 - HYDRABAD, the Court made the following;

ORDER:

Heard Mr. B. Mayur Reddy, learned senior counsel appearing for Mr. Sardar Jasbeer Singh, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr. Sameer Ahmad, learned standing counsel for respondents No.10 and 11 - HYDRAA.

Learned standing counsel for HYDRAA placed on record copy of the complaint lodged by one Dr. Moganti Gandhi dated 11.06.2026 requesting removal of unauthorized occupation of Sikh Community people in the HUDA park. It is stated that based on the said complaint, action has been initiated.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioners submitted that there is interference by the respondent authorities without following due process of law. The subject land of Ac.1.23 guntas in Sy.Nos.352/1 to 352/3 and 354/1 to 354/4, Attapur Village, Rajendranagar Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, had been in possession of the members of the Sikh Community. The property is popularly known as Gurudwara Shaheed Baba Albail Singh Asthan and religious activities are regularly performed.

In view of the above, status quo, obtaining as on today, shall be maintained in respect of structures of Gurudwara Shaheed Baba Albail Singh Asthan standing on the land in an extent of Ac.1.23 guntas in Sy.Nos.352/1 to 352/3 and 354/1 to 354/4, Attapur Village, Rajendranagar Mandal, Ranga Reddy District. This order, however, shall not come in the way of the respondents No.10 and 11 - HYDRAA in taking action against the petitioners, by issuing notice to the petitioners other interested persons and by following due process of law.
