petitioners and Mr.Dharmesh D.K.Jaiswal, learned counsel for respondent No.1 submits that at the instance of elders and well-wishers, the petitioners and respondent No.1 have entered into a settlement and filed applications vide I.A.Nos.3 and 4 of 2026 seeking to compound the offences and record the compromise. Along with the said applications, both parties have also filed a joint memo.

Learned counsel for the parties further submits that the parties will appear before the High Court Legal Services Committee for identification.

In view of the above said submission, Registry is directed to transmit the case file to the High Court Legal Services Committee immediately.

Hence, petitioner No.1 is directed to appear in person and petitioner No.2 and respondent No.1 are directed to appear virtually before the High Court Legal Services Committee on or before 30.06.2026. On such appearance, the High Court Legal Services Committee is directed to submit a report before this Court on or before the next date of hearing.
