WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI VEERA BABU GANDU presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondent No.4 filing the E.A.No.13 of 2026 in E.P.No.33 of 2025 filed against the petitioner pending on the file of IV Addl.Junior Civil Judge -cum-IV Addl.Judicial Magistrate of First class At Hanumakonda as illegal, arbitrary,unconstitutional and by setting a side the E.A.No.13 of 2026 in E.P. No.13 of 2022 in AA/CF/No.564/2024, dated.07-10-2024,and by declaring that the 4th respondent has no jurisdiction to execute the award and the recovery certificate with attachment of salary issued against the petitioner herein and consequently declare that the 3rd Respondent shall have no jurisdiction to entertain and pass the award in AA/CF/No.564 of 2024, dated.07-10-2024.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI VEERA BABU GANDU Advocate for the Petitioner and GP FOR REVENUE GENERAL (STAMPS AND REGISTRATION) for the Respondents no. 1 to 3 directed issue of notice to the Respondents no. 4 to 9 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 03.08.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings in pursuant to the Execution Proceedings in E.A.No.13 of 2026 in E.P.No.33 of 2025 filed against the petitioner pending on the file of IV Addl.Junior Civil Judge -cum-IV Addl.Judicial Magistrate of First class At Hanumakonda,pending on the file of Senior Civil Judge At Karim Nagar against the petitioner, pending disposal of WP No 19218 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following

ORDER:

Notice before admission.

Learned Government Pleader for Revenue General (Stamps and Registration) takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3, waives further notice and seeks time to file counter.

Registry is directed not to take out notice to respondents 1 to 3 in view of the above waiver.

The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent Nos.4 to 9 and to file proof of service in the registry.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits in *Punyamurthula Venkata Viswa Sundara Rao v. Margadarsi Chit Fund Private Limited, Hyderabad and others* [2017(3) ALD 387], the Division Bench of this Court held that the E.P. Court does not have jurisdiction to entertain an application for execution of the award passed by the Deputy Registrar of Chit Funds, if presented by the decree holder. However, in the instant case also, straightaway E.P.No.33 of 2025 in Arb/CF/No.564 of 2024 was filed before the learned Principal Junior Civil Judge, Hanamkonda against the petitioner and others, without it being presented/forwarded by the Registrar. In view of the decision referred to above, balance of convenience is in favour of the petitioner.

Hence, there shall be interim stay as prayed for insofar as petitioner is concerned.
