Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue any order, direction or Writ, more particularly in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents, more particularly Respondent No. 2, in affixing flexes/banners/hoardings dt. NIL on the Petitioners property on 04. 07. 2025 through which the Respondent No. 2 is demanding outstanding electricity dues and arrears of M/s. Priyadarshini Spinning Mills Ltd. towards service connection No. SCR 270 from the Petitioner herein and resorting to high- handed

actions such as entering into the premises of the 1st Petitioner i.e. total land admeasuring Ac. 34. 04 Gts in Sy. Nos. 723 Part, 724 and 725, Sadashivpet Village, Sadashivpet Mandal as being illegal, arbitrary and unconstitutional and contrary to the provisions of Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 and consequently set aside the said notice affixed in the subject property and all further proceedings by restraining the Respondents herein, more particularly Respondent No. 2 to 7 from issuing any such notices or taking any such further action against the Petitioners herein in future for payment/recovery of the electricity dues pending against M/s. Priyadarshini Spinning Mills Ltd. and further direct the Respondents No. 2 to 7 to restrain from insisting for payment of the electricity dues pending as against M/s. Priyadarshini Spinning Mills Ltd.

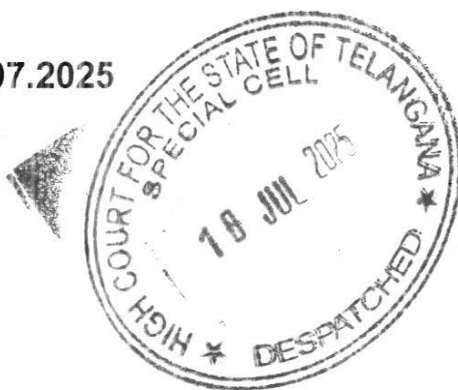
