ORDER:

This writ petition is filed with the following prayer:

"to issue any order, direction or Writ more particularly in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents more particularly Respondent No.2, in affixing flexes/banners/hoardings dated NIL on the Petitioners property on 04.07.2025 through which the Respondent No.2 is demanding outstanding electricity dues and arrears of M/s. Priyadarshini Spinning Mills Ltd. towards service connection No. SCR 270 from the Petitioner herein and resorting to high-handed actions such as entering into the premises of the 1st Petitioner i e total land admeasuring Ac.34.04 Gts in Sy Nos. 723 Part 724 and 725 Sadashivpet Village Sadashivpet Mandal as being illegal arbitrary and unconstitutional and contrary to the provisions of Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 and consequently set aside the said notice affixed in the subject property and all further proceedings by restraining the Respondents herein more particularly Respondent No 2 to 7 from issuing any such notices or taking any such further action against the Petitioners herein in future for payment/recovery of the electricity dues pending against M/s.Priyadarshini Spinning Mills Ltd and further direct the Respondents No 2 to 7 to restrain from insisting for payment of the electricity dues pending as against M/s Priyadarshini Spinning Mills Ltd and pass..."



2. Heard Mr. Vadeendra Joshi, learned counsel for the petitioners, learned Government Pleader for Power Supply and Energy for respondent No.1 and Mr. N. Sreedhar Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for respondent Nos.2 to 7. Both the learned counsel submit that the issue in this Writ Petition is squarely covered by the order dated 16.03.2006 in W.P.No.27253 of 2005, which was allowed holding as under:

“In the result, the writ petition is allowed and the impugned demand notice issued in Lr.No.SE/OP/MCL/SAO/AAO(HT)/JAO(HT)/d.No.1328, dated 26.07.2025 issued to the petitioner claiming arrears of Rs.2,64,364/- pertaining to the period 2008-09 in respect of the petitioner's unit is set aside and consequently, the respondents are directed not to disconnect the power supply to the unit of the petitioner pursuant to the said demand notice.”

3. In the circumstances, following the above order and for the reasons mentioned therein, this Writ Petition is also allowed setting aside the notice affixed on the petitioner's property on 04.07.2025 and consequently, the respondents are directed not to disconnect the power supply to the unit of the petitioner pursuant to the said notice. There shall be no order as to costs.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any pending, shall stand closed.

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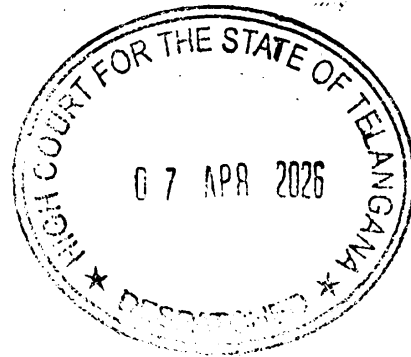
