WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI. C THIRUPATHI RAO presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order, or Direction, particularly in the nature of a Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the respondents 2 to 5 in not releasing the pending bill to the petitioner pertaining to the Supply and Erecting of Chain Link Fencing of 2.40 Kms. (35 Ha) around at Isukaregadi Area, Comp. No. 122, Somachelka (E) Beat of Samachelaka Section of Maddimadugu Range in Amrabad Division ATR Circle for the year 2024-25, inspite of multiple remainders and issuance of Legal Notice dated 27.04.2026 as highly illegal, arbitrary and in violation of terms of the contract, consequently direct the respondents 2 to 5 to forthwith release the pending bill amount of Rs.16,24,926/- + Rs. 2,92,487/- towards Balance EMD at 2.5percent, + Rs.4,38,922/- towards FSD at 5 percent Rs.2,14,020/- towards Balance EMD and Rs.4,28,039.05 towards 5 percent price escalation withheld with the respondents and agreed to be paid with the final bill (as per Article No.2 of the Articles of Agreement, dated 12.12.2024), totalling to Rs.29,98,394.05 (Rupees Twenty Nine Lakhs Ninety Eight Thousand

Three Hundred Ninety Four Rupees and Five Paise Only) along with interest accrued thereon at 24percent per annum since the month of May, 2024,

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. C THIRUPATHI RAO Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
