ORDER

This Criminal Petition is filed by the petitioners/accused Nos.1 to 3 seeking to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.223 of 2024 on the file of the learned III Additional Junior Civil Judge, Nalgonda.

2. Heard Mr.C.Thirupathi Rao, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr.Jithender Rao Veeramalla, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for respondent No.1.

3. When this Court is not inclined to entertain the criminal petition to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.223 of 2024, exercising jurisdiction under the provisions of Section 528 of the

BNSS, on the ground that specific allegations are levelled against the petitioners, and the allegations in the complaint as well as in the final report disclose cognizable offences, and LWs. 2 to 4, who are eye-witnesses, have specifically mentioned the role of the petitioners. Whether the statements recorded by the Investigating Officer under Section 161 of the Cr.P.C. or the allegations levelled in the complaint and final report are true or not has to be revealed during the course of trial. At this juncture, the learned counsel for the petitioners requested this Court to dispense with the personal appearance of the petitioners/accused Nos. 1 to 3 in C.C.No.223 of 2024 on the file of the learned III Additional Junior Civil Judge, Nalgonda, as the matter before the trial Court has not yet ripened for trial.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor has not opposed the submissions made by the learned counsel for petitioners.

5. In view of the above submissions, the presence of the petitioners/accused Nos.1 to 3 in C.C.No.223 of 2024 on the file of the learned III Additional Junior Civil Judge, Nalgonda, is dispensed with, subject to the condition that they shall be

represented through their counsel on each and every date of hearing. If the presence of the petitioners is required, they shall appear before the trial Court. In case of their non-appearance on the specific date fixed by the trial Court for their appearance, the trial Court is entitled to proceed with the matter, in accordance with law.

6. Accordingly, the criminal petition is disposed of.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed.

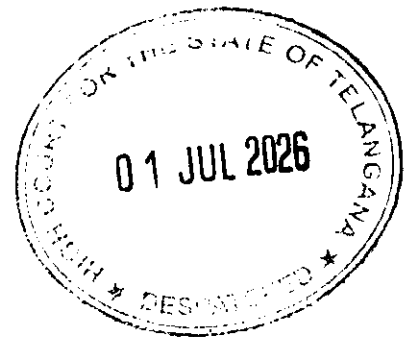
