01.	19.06.2026	<u>JSR, J</u> <u>I.A.No.1 of 2026</u> Dispensed with for the present. <u>JSR,J</u> <u>CrI.P.No.9204 of 2026</u> This Criminal Petition is filed by the petitioner/accused No.1 seeking to quash the proceedings in FIR No.762 of 2021 of Uppal Police Station, Malkajgiri Commissionerate, for the offences punishable under Sections 498-A and 504 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 3 and 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that at the instance of elders and well-wishers, the petitioner, respondent No.2 and other accused have entered into a settlement and petitioner and respondent No.2 have filed applications vide I.A.Nos.2 and 3 of 2026 seeking to compound the offence and record the compromise. Along with the said applications, both parties have also filed a joint memo. When this Court raised a query as to whether respondent No.2 is entitled to seek a record of compromise and compound the offences in respect of	Transferred to i.o. folder before corrections, if any.

the petitioner/accused No.1 alone, at this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that accused Nos.2 to 5 have filed a separate criminal petition, vide CrI.P.No.129 of 2022, seeking to quash the very same proceedings. In the said case also, the parties are taking appropriate steps for filing permission petition and a compromise petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is presently residing in the USA due to his employment and has executed a GPA in favour of one Bellamkonda Sivaji Raju, who is none other than his father. Unless this Court permits the GPA holder to prosecute the proceedings on behalf of the petitioner, he will be put to great hardship.

Taking into consideration the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, the GPA holder of the petitioner and respondent No. 2 are directed to appear before the High Court Legal Services Committee on or before 24.06.2026. The GPA holder is directed to produce the identity proof of the petitioner. The petitioner/accused No.1 is directed to appear through video conference. On such appearance, the High Court Legal Services Committee shall submit a report before this Court on or before the next date of hearing.

Hence, the Registry is directed to transmit the case file to the High Court Legal Services Committee immediately.
